

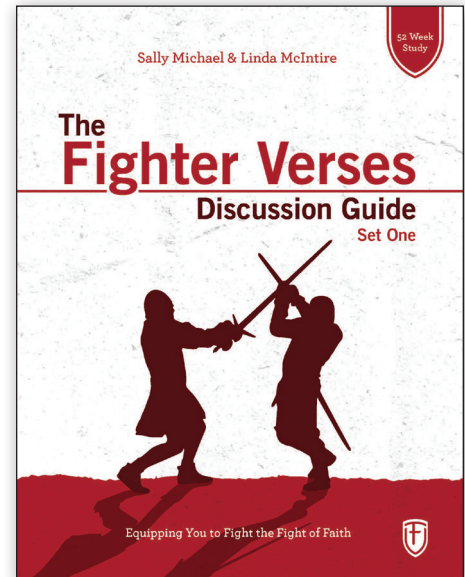


The Fighter Verses Study, Set One, Part A

Equipping You to Fight the Fight of Faith

Building relationships that are deep, lasting, and meaningful requires time spent listening and talking together. Nurturing a relationship with God is no different. **The Fighter Verses Study** is a year-long devotional that will help you spend quality "bites" of time with God as you study the verses found in Set One of the Fighter Verses Bible memory program.

The quarterly version of **The Fighter Verses Study** includes 13 lessons from the year-long study. Each quarterly study can be done in order following the year-long schedule, or you can study the parts independently in any order. Part A includes Fighter Verses 1-13.



Fighter Verses 1: **Deuteronomy 7:9**

Faithfulness of God

"Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations,"

Fighter Verses 2: **Deuteronomy 10:12-13**

Obedying God

"And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all his ways, to love him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, ¹³and to keep the commandments and statutes of the LORD, which I am commanding you today for your good?"

Fighter Verses 3: **John 1:12-13**

Salvation

But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, ¹³who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

Fighter Verses 4: **Romans 11:33-36**

Sovereignty of God

Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways! ³⁴"For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?" ³⁵"Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?" ³⁶For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen.

Fighter Verses 5: **Romans 12:1-2**

Sanctification

I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. ²Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Fighter Verses 6: **Psalms 56:3-4**

Battling Fear

When I am afraid, I put my trust in you. ⁴In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I shall not be afraid. What can flesh do to me?

Fighter Verses 7: Psalm 62:5-7 [8]

Trusting God

For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. ⁶He only is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be shaken. ⁷On God rests my salvation and my glory; my mighty rock, my refuge is God. [⁸Trust in him at all times, O people; pour out your heart before him; God is a refuge for us.]

Fighter Verses 8: Romans 8:1

Work of Christ

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

Fighter Verses 9: 1 John 2:15-17

Battling Sin

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. ¹⁶For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride in possessions—is not from the Father but is from the world. ¹⁷And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.

Fighter Verses 10: Philippians 2:5-7

Humility of Christ

Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, ⁶who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.

Fighter Verses 11: Philippians 2:8-9

Humility of Christ

And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. ⁹Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name,

Fighter Verses 12: Philippians 2:10-11

Supremacy of Jesus

...so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Fighter Verses 13: Philippians 2:12-13

Sanctification

Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, so now, not only as in my presence but much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling, ¹³for it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for his good pleasure.
